

APPURTENANCES PLACED IN TOWN ROADS
Town of Wilmot

The Wilmot Board of Selectmen has adopted the following policy in regards to appurtenances in town roads.

Anything placed in the Right-of-Way (ROW) will be done so only with written permission of the Board of Selectmen, Road Agent or Assignee. A signed appurtenance form will be on file at the Highway Department before any work/or item is placed in the ROW.

Appurtenances include, but are not limited to: mailboxes, newspaper boxes, fences, stonewalls, hedges, trees, shrubs, landscape timbers, and granite curb. Items such as these located within the town ROW exist by sufferance only, with responsibility assumed by the owner.

It is not possible for the town to repair or replace any items within a town ROW (including grass and turf) that has been damaged or destroyed as a result of town road maintenance.

Any person who violates any provision of the policy shall be subject to a penalty in the amount of \$100 (one hundred) for a first violation, \$300 (three hundred) for a second violation and \$500 (five hundred) for a third violation. Such person shall be deemed to have committed a separate violation for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of the policy is committed, continued or permitted by such person.
