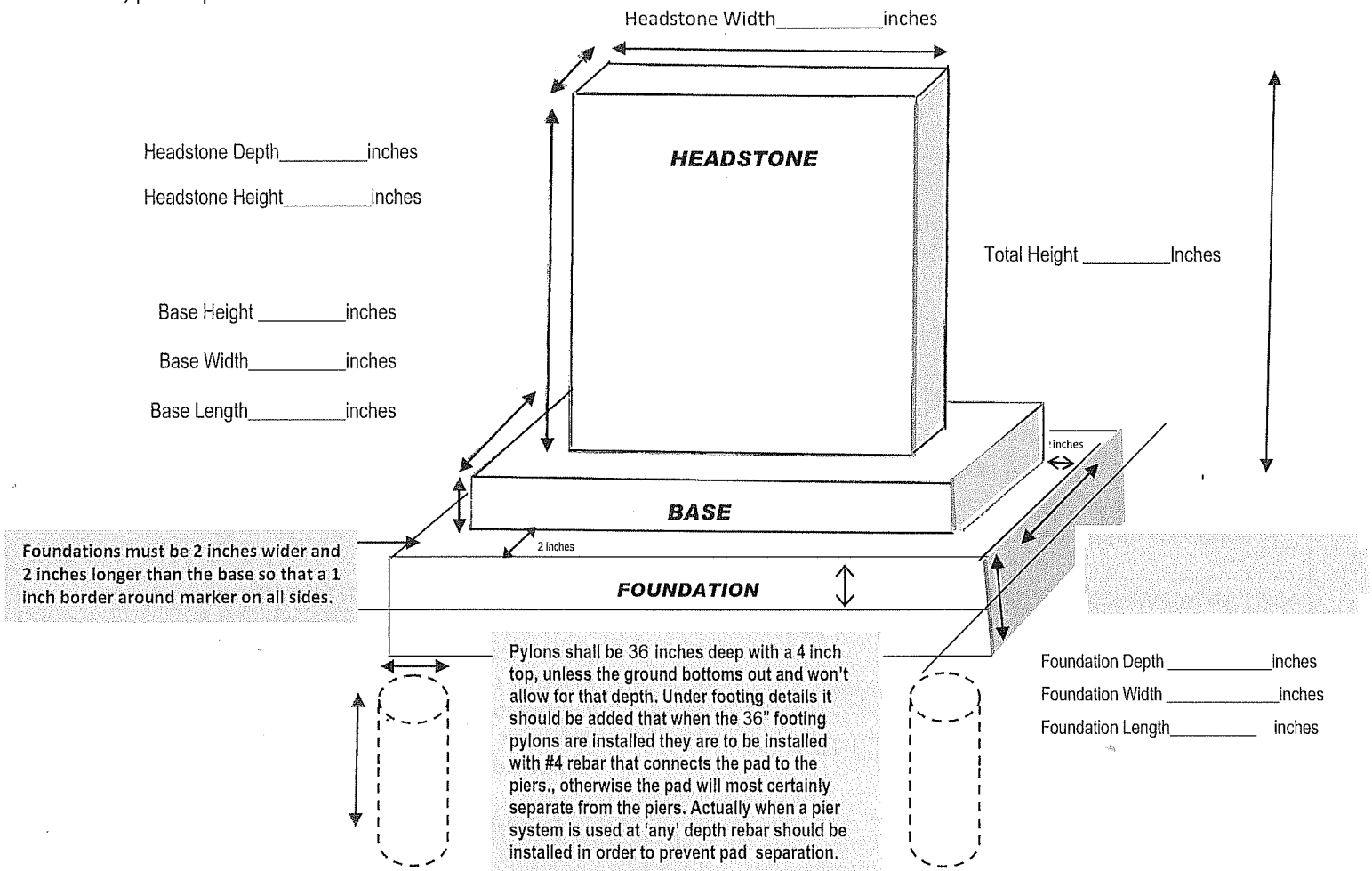
FOUNDATIONS

The Wilmot Cemetery Trustee's Rules and Regulations require that all monuments /markers/ headstones be installed on a foundation in accordance with the following specifications:

- Foundation shall be 36 inches deep, unless the ground bottoms out and won't allow for that depth. This can be two pylons, 36 inches deep with a 4 inch top, or 36 inches of solid cement poured wet, not dry.
- Foundations shall be at least four (4) inches wider and four (4) inches longer than the marker so that a two (2) inch border is around the marker on all sides.
